

## Responsive Prayer Service

1. **Spiritual Leader** - Jesus did not organize a church on earth. Jesus' church was an organization of divine ideas for abundant living, which is an exact science.  
**Congregation** - "Know ye not that ye are the temple of the living God and the spirit of God dwelleth within you?"
2. **Spiritual Leader** - God is not a Being with many parts, but Being with potentialities. God does not have what we desire, God is what we desire.  
**Congregation** - "There is only one Presence and one Power, God the good, omnipotent."
3. **Spiritual Leader** - We are created in the image of God. Our unfoldment to happy and abundant living depends not on our becoming something different from that which we are, but in being what we are to the fullest extent.  
**Congregation** - "I am a perfect child of God, perfect in mind and perfect in expression."
4. **Spiritual Leader** - Jesus and Christ are not synonymous terms. Jesus is the man who demonstrated His God-likeness to the fullest extent and thus put on the Christ. Christ is not a person but a principle of divine sonship.  
**Congregation** - "Jesus is my teacher and wayshower. I willingly follow Him in the path of overcoming."
5. **Spiritual Leader** - The keynote of the Christian teaching is, "Christ in you the hope of glory." We must clearly distinguish between God's man and the Christ, which is perfect and complete and Adam's man the human man, which is in a state of becoming.  
**Congregation** - "Through Christ in me I can do all things."
6. **Spiritual Leader** - Mind is the connecting link between God and the individual. Our mind is our world. Our thoughts are

the tools with which we carve our life's story on the substance of the universe. When we rule our thoughts we rule the world.

**Congregation** - "My mind is my kingdom, I rule it wisely."

7. **Spiritual Leader** - In self-unfoldment two "handles to power" most needful are the use of denials to wipe out of our mind the mistaken beliefs of a lifetime, and affirmations to build Truth principles into our consciousness.  
**Congregation** - "I release and relinquish all that is negative in my life and claim for my own the positive power of the Christ mind."
8. **Spiritual Leader** - Prayer is not something we do for God but something we do for ourselves. Communion with God is turning at the point of human limitation to the point of supreme limitlessness. Prayer is silent communion with God.  
**Congregation** - "Be still and know that I am God."
9. **Spiritual Leader** - Through the strengthening of faith we open unto ourselves an "added dimension" of infinite possibilities for abundant living. Faith is a spiritual perception of one's good even before good is manifest.  
**Congregation** - "I have faith in myself, and I have faith in my ability through Christ to do all things."
10. **Spiritual Leader** - Words are the most powerful agents of mind. "Every idle word that men shall speak they shall give account thereof." "Death and life are in the power of the tongue."  
**Congregation** - "I speak only that which is good and constructive."

11. **Spiritual Leader** – Life is consciousness. We demonstrate to the limit of our consciousness. The only way we can have more is to increase of consciousness. There is no abrogation of this law.

**Congregation** – “I seek constantly to know the Law and to demonstrate its power.”

12. **Spiritual Leader** - We all tend to become centered in things of the world, but Jesus taught, “Seek ye first the kingdom of God and God’s righteousness and all these things shall be added . . .” We must seek the inner realization of our oneness with God and then rightly use this consciousness in what we think, say, and do.

**Congregation** – “I dwell in the secret place of the most high.”

13. **Spiritual Leader** - The object of our existence is the development of our soul. Any attainment, either mental or material, that cannot be associated with and counted as an aid toward our soul development will ultimately be refused.

**Congregation** – “My soul doth magnify the Lord.”

14. **Spiritual Leader** - In our spiritual ongoing, as Truth students we reach the point when, like Jesus our Master and Teacher, we must call to ourselves our own twelve apostles, our own twelve faculties of mind, that they be trained to function more righteously.

**Congregation** – “I stir up the gift of God that is within me, and I am blessed on every hand with happiness, soul satisfaction and true achievement.”

15. **Spiritual Leader** – There is no instant when a person should withhold love through unforgiveness. When you withhold love you retard the action of the mighty healing and prospering and redeeming power.

**Congregation** – “I meet all persons and circumstances in the spirit of love and on-resistance.”

16. **Spiritual Leader** - There is no power and no reality in sin. Sin is its own punishment, and righteousness is its own reward. Each person is equipped with the power to think and live aright, but through the use of our inner power we must work out our own salvation.

**Congregation** – “I give thanks for an ever-increasing knowledge of Truth that makes me free from all sin and error.”

17. **Spiritual Leader** - Health and perfection are our divine rights, God changeless will for us, God’s creations. No matter what the condition, we can be healed if we will accept completely, the Truth idea of one perfect Creator and one perfect creation.

**Congregation** – “God is my health, I can’t be sick”

18. **Spiritual Leader** - Prosperity is God’s will for humankind. We will be prosperous if we increase of consciousness of God as our unfailing supply, and expand our vision to behold ourselves as being unlimited in any way.

**Congregation** – “God is my instant, constant and abundant supply.”

19. **Spiritual Leader** - There is no such thing as getting something for nothing. We must give full measure for all that we receive. “As ye sow so shall ye reap.” “Give and ye shall receive.”

**Congregation** – “The Divine law of giving and receiving is fulfilled in and through me.”

20. **Spiritual Leader** - We were not born to die but to live and to progress toward the goal of perfection. The death experience lies within the consciousness of humankind, and not in the will of God.

**Congregation** – “I am the ever-renewing, ever-unfolding, expression of eternal and never-ending life.”
